Winter Storm Mara	\$36,708,455 (Est.)	\$0	FEMA	All disaster categories are eligible. The initial estimate of City expenses as reviewed by FEMA for the purpose of issuing the declaration is \$36,708,455. The City has until August to provide the full scope of work, and until October 2024 to complete repairs. Expenses are still being incurred and tallied; the total will be confirmed at a later point. After projects are compiled, submitted, and reviewed by FEMA and the State, reimbursements will be made to cover 75% of eligible costs.
