REQUEST: Which projects in District 6 are currently allocated general obligation bond funds in the 2023-2024 fiscal year?

RESPONSE:

The following table shows general obligation public improvement bond debt-funded capital improvement projects that are mapped and located in Council District 6, which have an identified spending plan in FY 2023-24. Please note that any project listed may have additional funding sources beyond general obligation debt, and depending on the phase of the project, the mapping may not be available and therefore not included in the list below.

Furthermore, capital improvement projects may provide either citywide benefits that are not specific to a Council district or may mostly reside in another Council district, but bordering districts may receive benefits from that project. Many City of Austin capital improvement projects are not funded through general obligation debt, such as Austin Energy and Austin Water projects, which comprise 35% of the FY 2023-24 Five-Year CIP Plan spending projections.
