REQUEST: What is the amount allocated to community service providers, including Jane's Due Process, for reproductive health care services?

RESPONSE:

Austin Public Health has \$150,000 for community service providers to provide education and reproductive health resources navigation. In addition, APH provides the below services related to reproductive health:

- With \$20,000 in grant funding, the HIV Outreach treatment teams distribute condoms (male and female) through clinics, outreach testing, and deliveries to a variety of businesses.
- The Sexual Health Clinic provides screening for HIV, syphilis, gonorrhea, chlamydia, and other STIs to approximately 11,000 visits per year and treatment for STIs.
- The Austin Healthy Adolescent (AHA) Program supports youth in taking ownership of their health. AHA uses an evidence-based sexual health curriculum focused on reducing unintended teen pregnancies. \$565,010 is included in the FY24 General Fund with an additional \$226,161 in the DSRIP Special Revenue budget. AHA also receives \$838,100 in federal grant funds from Health and Human Services.
