REQUEST: How much would it cost to provide holiday pay to temporaries, broken down by

department.

#### **RESPONSE:**

#### Assumptions:

- Number of temporary employees would remain static for each holiday
- Wages for those temporaries will not change between now and the holiday, except those earning less than \$20.80 would be paid \$20.80 (the proposed living wage)
- Budgeted hours for those temporaries will not change between now and the holiday
- Response includes the cost of FICA (7.45%)
- Christmas is not treated any differently than any other holiday for purposes of this analysis
- Personal and "optional" (e.g., Let Texas Vote) holidays are not included
- This assumes 12 holidays

For one day of holiday pay for temporary employees, it would cost \$394K to the General Fund, or \$646K for all funds.

For 12 days of holiday pay for temporary employees, it would cost \$4.7M to the General Fund, or \$7.7M for all funds.

The per-holiday costs are attached, broken down by department and fund.
