

Regular meeting of the City Council : Austin, Texas, Feb'y 12th 1914.

Roll called : Present Mayor Wooldridge, Councilmen Anthony, Bartholomew, Haynes and Powell 5

Absent none.

The minutes of the last regular and subsequent recessed meetings were read and approved.

Reports of City Officers:

The Mayor laid before the Council the reports of the Sexton & the Inspector of Weights and Measures for January, 1914 and that of the Supt of Streets, Sanitary Sewer fund for the month of Dec 1913, which were read and ordered filed.

Councilman Powell offered the following resolution :

Be it resolved by the City Council of the City of Austin :

That the City Treasurer be instructed to transfer the sum of three hundred fourteen and 42/100, (\$ 314.42) dollars, from the permanent Street Improvement fund to the General street fund to reimburse said fund for the amount which was erroneously drawn by No 36811, 36890, 37020 to 37032, 37033 to 37036, and 37037 to 37056.

The resolution was adopted by the following vote:

The Mayor laid before the Council An Ordinance regulating the storage and handling of Gasoline and other volatiles and inflammable liquids, within the City of Austin, which was read the first time.

Councilman Haynes presented a bill from the Citizens Bank & Trust Co, for \$ 110.24, Interest on overdrafts for General fund for the month of January 1914, which was ordered paid by the following vote:


