The following was then read
To the Board of Aldermen
In authority of Article (5)
Five sections (1) one of the City Charter. I hereby call a
special Meeting of the City Council to meet at the Council
Chamber at the City Hall on this day (June 10th 1889) at

certified copy of an order made by the Commissioners Court
of Travis County, recinding the contract existing between
the City of Austin and Travis County in regard to maintaining
the City and County Hospital.

Under Call

Alderman Yellin moved a call of the Council which was
agreed to and the Marshal instructed to bring in the Absentees
a quess of twenty (20) minutes was taken when Aldermen
Jones and Wilson answered to their names.

Hospital

The Mayor then introduced the following copy of an order
of the Commissioners Court to wit:
"On this May 21st 1889 it was ordered by the Court that
the contract between Austin City and Travis County in
reference to Hospital be annulled"

 Travis County, Texas, as the same appears of record in my
 office. Given under my hand and seal of said Court.

Alderman Poland made a motion that the Mayor appoint
 a committee of three to confer with the Commissioners Court
 of Travis County and to report their action at a subsequent
 meeting of the City Council to be called by the Mayor.
 After a few desultory remarks, pro and con engaged in by
 Aldermen Poland, Nelson, Graham, Linn and Yeller
 Alderman Graham moved that the words "Hospital Committee"
 be substituted by "Committee of three" which was agreed to and
 Alderman Poland's motion as amended passed unanimously.

On motion the Council adjourned.
