

Called Meeting of City Council
 Quarter Days October 15, 1878.
 Mayor Holess presiding. Roll called
 Present. Aldermen Crow, Crooker, Kestz,
 Raven, Sheehan and Strong.

Quorum present. Alderman Crow moved
 a call of the Council. Call suspended.

A communication from City Recorder
 Recorder Quarter Day Dept dated Oct 14,
 1878 was being read, stating that at a
 meeting of the officers of the Fire Dept held
 on the 12th of Octy, a two-third majority of
 all the officers being present, an election
 for Chief and Asst Chief Engineer was had
 resulting as follows; viz:

For Chief, Jas. A. Eagle

Asst Chief August Zeller

On motion the communication was received
 and the action of the officers of the Dept
 confirmed.

Petition of W. D. Anderson and J. H. S. Pealove
 to open a butcher market, outside the market
 limits.

Petition granted.

Petition of Geo. B. Zumpelgran to have his
 warehouse situated on the corner of Pine
 Street and East Avenue recognized as a
 cotton warehouse.

Petition granted.

Petition of G. G. Wading and J. A. Bromfield to
 establish a shooting gallery on Congress Avenue.

Petition granted.

The following resolution was read first
 time.

A resolution removing and placing the
 City alarm bell of this city.

Resolved that the sum of Two Hundred
 and fifty dollars or so much thereof as
 may be necessary be and the same is
 hereby appropriated to move the fire alarm
 bell from its present situation to the
 Market House.

There not being two thirds of a full

Council present, the 6 Aldermen who were present agreed to sustain the Mayor in proceeding with the work.

The following resolution introduced by Alderman Sheehan was read first time.

By its resolved by the City Council of the City of Austin that the sum of five hundred dollars, or so much thereof as may be necessary by and the same is hereby appropriated for the purpose of building a bridge over a branch on West Boerid' Ave Street between Rio Grande and San Antonio Street. X
