

Called meeting of City Council,  
 Austin, Texas, Aug 16, 1878.  
 Mayor De Gross presiding.  
 Roll called. Present Aldermen Crocker,  
 Mallett, Metz, Platts, Sheehan and Strong. 6.  
 Quorum present. The following  
 business was transacted.  
 Messrs Dexter and Reed attorneys of  
 the licensed retail liquor dealers of the  
 city of Austin, presented a petition pro-  
 testing against the action of the Council  
 in granting Chas. Olsen the privilege of  
 obtaining liquor without license.  
 On motion the Mayor was instructed to  
 withhold the first license granted to the  
 said Olsen until the further action of  
 the Council.  
 The City Physician presented a report  
 signed by the Physicians of Austin relative  
 to the sanitary condition of the city, its  
 liability to Yellow fever epidemic and  
 making certain recommendations. The  
 report was read for the information of the  
 Council and on motion was ordered printed.  
 On motion the Council adjourned.
