Austin Texas, July 31st 1878.

Mayor De Gress Presiding, Rally Called.
Present Aldermen Millett, Carr, Sheehan,
Strong and Vaughan.

Alderman Millett moved a call of the
Council. The call being sustained by
three the Marshal was dispatched for
the absentees. Aldermen Crooker and
Kalle appeared and answers to their
names and on motion the call was
suspended.

The following business was transacted.
An Ordinance adopting and amending
the revised ordinances of the City of
Austin.

Read first, second and third times and
passed, two thirds of a full Council voting
in the affirmative.

Report of City Attorney relative to licensing
scourgers together with an ordinance
on the subject.

Report received

An Ordinance licensing night scav-
engers and regulating the work thereof.
Read first, second and third times and
passed under a suspension of the
rules two thirds of a full Council
voting in the affirmative.

Account of Jas. T. Miller for rent of
snow for Washington Allee Co. # 11.

On motions referred to committee on
Fire Department.

Petition of ladies and citizens relative
to the blowing at night of the whistles
of the Ice Factories.

Referred to the City Attorney.

Petition of David Frydman for mail
liquor license. Granted

Report of City Physician relative to
digging trenches for sewers on.

Report received and orders published.
By order of the Council Alderman Crow,

Metz and Platt were fined one dollar
each for non-attendance.

On motion the Council adjourned.
