City Council met pursuant to a special call
His Honor Leander Brown Mayor in the Chair
Roll called, and the following named Aldersman
was present Aldersman Bessett, Baker,
Pulso, Rosenschke, Collins and Raves
Aldersman Baker introduced the following
Resolutions, which was on motion seconded, adopted. —

Whereas, the City Council of Austin
recognizes the great importance of railroad
communications with the outside world, and are
heavily desirous of rendering every assistance
in our power to further this object; therefore, be
it resolved by the City Council of the City of Austin
that in case the Central Railroad Company do not
desire to use the lots donated by the City Sept of
September 1868, we will furnish suitable ground for
a passenger depot in any other part of the City
when it may be desired, and can be obtained.
