Monday August 1st 1870

City Council met pursuant to adjournment
His Honor Leander Brown Mayor in the Chair
Roll called and the following named Alderman
answered to their Names. Alderman. Bennett
Baker, Palm, Paves and Rosenschke

Minutes of the 24th and 5th July were read
and adopted.

Reports for the 3rd Quarters of the Fiscal
year, was presented by His Honor the Mayor the Supt
or and Collector and by the Treasurer were presented
and read.

The Reports show that there is \$100 specie
balance in the hands of the Mayor and \$544⁵⁸ in
the hands of the City Treasurer.

The Assessor and Collectors report shows \$212.⁵²
Currency to be due to him. On motion these reports
were referred to the Finance Committee.

Report by the City Sexton for the month of
July was presented and read. Showing 15th deaths of
adults and Eight Children

Alderman Paves moved that

" Be it Ordained that in Article 168 Section 1
and line 6 the word ten be stricken out and the
word one be substituted" which on motion, was
read, rules suspended and the Ordinance passed
its 2^d and 3^d reading, and passed by a unanimous
Vote

Alderman Baker introduced the following
Resolution.

Resolved that after the 1st day of
August 1870, the salary of the City Marshal,
shall be fifty dollars per month with fee of Office,
which resolution being read was ~~on motion~~
seconded and ^{on motion} the roll being called was adopted by
the following vote: Alderman Bennett, Baker,
Palm, Paves, and Rosenschke Voting Aye

Alderman Baker introduced the following
Resolution

Resolved that the Mayor be authorized
to issue ten percent City Warrants in sums of

One hundred dollars, ^{Each} to the amount ^{of} three thousand two hundred and sixty two dollars and sixty cents, or as much thereof as may be necessary to complete the payment on the Market house, according to the contracts made with A. H. Cook and Loomis and Christian, said warrants to be due and payable six months from date.
