City Council met pursuant to adjournment His Honor Leader Brown Mayor in the Chair, Roll called and the following Aldermen answered to their names: Alderman Bennett, Baker, Raven, Hancock & Co. Minutes of the regular meeting and called meetings read and adopted.

The Committee on Ordinances is referred to Houses of all fame, reported in favor of the same except sections 3 and 4.

Report of the Committee received and adopted and said Committee discharged from further consideration of the same.

Sections Report for June was read and received.

The Ordinance was then read, section by section and passed on its first reading.

Resolved that the Mayor be requested to consult ^{with} the Governor and other good authorities upon the Constitutionality of the 5th Section, and report at the next ^{meeting} of the City Council.

Resolved that the Mayor be requested to ask the Governor, whether he will appoint a City Marshal, or whether he will authorize the City Council to name a suitable person for the Office.

The Council adjourned until the next regular meeting.
