

Monday June 28th 5 PM

The City Council met pursuant to a call, by His Honor the Mayor Leander Brown Presiding.

Alderman present, Alderman Bennett, Roushke, Raven, and Fox, Alderman Palm and Collins absent.

The Mayor announced the special business of the meeting to be the subject of Houses of ill fame, which Ordinance was then introduced and referred to a special committee of Alderman Baker, Bennett and Fox who should report at the next meeting.

Alderman Raven offered the following Ordinance
City Ordinance

Be it Ordained by the City Council of the City of Austin. That the Mayor of said City, he, and he is hereby authorized and empowered to sell at either public or private sale, and on such terms as to him may seem most advantageous to said City, the Block in said City known and marked on the map of said City as Hospital Block, lying north of Block N^o 166 and east of Block N^o 167 and to execute to the purchaser of said Block a title thereto and this Ordinance take effect and be in force after its passage: provided that the amount to be realized from said sale shall not be less than twelve hundred Dollars.

Ordinance read first, second, and ^{third} time and Ordered to its third reading, put on its final passage, and passed by the following, ^{Vote} Alderman Bennett, Baker, Raven and Roushke and Fox
