

ORDINANCE NO. 841004-V

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING CHAPTER 13-2 OF THE AUSTIN CITY CODE OF 1981 BY PERMITTING GREEN PARK, LOCALLY KNOWN AS 4662 ROCKCLIFF ROAD TO BE USED FOR A PLANNED UNIT DEVELOPMENT; SAID PROPERTY BEING LOCATED IN AUSTIN, TRAVIS COUNTY, TEXAS; SUSPENDING THE RULE REQUIRING THE READING OF ORDINANCES ON THREE SEPARATE DAYS; AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF AUSTIN:

PART 1. That Chapter 13-2 of the Austin City Code of 1981 is hereby amended to permit the property described in File C814-84-021 to be used for a Planned Unit Development, to-wit:

14.916 acres of land out of the William Brown Survey No. 2 and the Thomas Gray Survey No. 2 in Travis County, Texas, said 14.916 acres being out of a 34.85 acre tract as recorded in Vol. 6957, Page 1432, of the Travis County Deed Records, said 14.916 acres being more particularly described by metes and bounds in Exhibit "A", attached hereto and made a part hereof for all purposes,

locally known as 4662 Rockcliff Road in the City of Austin, Travis County, Texas.

PART 2. That the development of the property herein described shall be accomplished in accordance with the site plan submitted and approved by both the City Planning Commission and the City Council, which is on file in the Planning Department of the City of Austin.

PART 3. That except to the extent the site plan referred to herein is inconsistent therewith, the development and use of the property described herein shall be in accordance with the ordinance of the City of Austin governing the development and use of property zoned "LA" Lake Austin Residence, First Height and Area District.

PART 4. It is hereby ordered that the zoning maps accompanying Chapter 13-2 of the Austin City Code of 1981 and made a part thereof shall be changed so as to record the change ordered in this ordinance.

PART 5. WHEREAS, an emergency is apparent for the immediate preservation of order, health safety and general welfare of the public, which emergency requires the suspension of the rule providing for the reading of an ordinance on three

separate days, and requires that this ordinance become effective immediately upon its passage; therefore, the rule requiring the reading on three separate days is hereby suspended and this ordinance shall become effective immediately upon its passage as provided by the Charter of the City of Austin.




