REGULAR MEETING WEDNESDAY, JANUARY 20, 2010

The Downtown Commission convened in a regular meeting on Wednesday, January 20, 2010, at 301 W. 2nd St. in Austin, Texas.

Chair Mandy Dealey called the Commission Meeting to order at 5:35 p.m.

1. CALL TO ORDER AND INTRODUCTIONS

2. CITIZEN COMMUNICATION: GENERAL

3. APPROVAL OF MINUTES

The minutes from the December 16, 2009 meeting were approved on Commission Member Daniels' motion, Commission Member Schorre's second, on an 10-0-1 vote, with Commission members McGill abstaining.

Molly Alexander, Associate Director of the Downtown Austin Alliance introduced Marie Crane, Ph.D, who made the presentation.

5. NEW CENTRAL LIBRARY STATUS REPORT

The presentation was made by John Gillum, Facilities Planning Manager for the City of Austin Library Department.

A resolution, adopting formal support for the idea that the City of Austin look for alternate funding sources to fund library parking, so that more of the funding allocated for the library project go for library uses, was approved on Commission Member Weiss' motion, Commission Member McGill's second on an 11-0 vote.

After discussion, the Commission requested that staff from the Planning and Development Review Department brief the Commission on the background on the Overlay District and whether its requirements should be revisited.
