The Board would like to review the TCEQ permits to make sure there's not any additions. 3. The Board would like to know who the contact person is with TCEO that does the annual inspections and the single point of contact person prior to moving forward with this development. 4. The Board requested a statement in writing of the 3.5 acres service area in accordance with the permit, or an idea that the permit will be changed. 6. The Board requested copy of permit to be placed in the backup material. 7. The Board requested explanation of what a 1015 permit is and what that means to water quality 8. The Board requested better maps to be placed in the packet material showing Little Barton Creek, and how far in distance this project is from Little Barton Creek.

b. Overview of Zoning and Impervious Cover-Wendy Rhoades, Planning and Development Department

This item was conducted as posted. The Environmental Board invited the Planning & Development Review Department staff to attend the April 21, 2010 Board and Staff to give a further explanation. Chairman Maxwell requested that the Board receive a copy of the additional slides on the impervious cover section. Chairman Maxwell and Board member Moncada are concerned with impervious cover allowed by zoning regulations versus impervious cover allowed by the

City's watershed regulations. Two specific items: Water Quality and Flooding Potential accumulative over a larger picture. What tracking measures are Planning and Development Review doing with variances to impervious cover granted by the Board of Adjustment? Board member Beall requested information about the expiration and extension of site plans. Board member Anderson requested to see a graphic depiction of the percentage of the impervious cover citywide. Chairman Maxwell requested information about the percentage of impervious cover in the central city, and how the built-out environment impacts the water that drains to the creeks, for example, Waller Creek and Gilleland Creek. Staff will brief the Environmental Board on April 7, 2010 about the Jollyville Plateau Salamander Candidate Conservation Agreement with Assurances that we are developing with U.S. Fish and Wildlife Service.

This item was conducted as posted. The Environmental Board members requests that the Austin Water Utility to come back in April make a financial report relating to Water Treatment Plant #4.
