Summary: Austin Water Utility requests authorization to issue a rebate in an amount not to exceed \$100,000.00 to Spansion Inc. for the installation of treatment equipment and distribution piping to allow the use of manufacture rinse water in cooling towers and equipment in place of potable water. The rebate is in accordance with Austin Water Utility Commercial Water Conservation Incentive Program.

This program provides incentives to large industrial, commercial and institutional facilities to implement water saving projects. The project proposed by Spansion Inc. will cost Spansion Inc. approximately \$930,000 and will save approximately 400,000 gallons of water per day, which is about 100 million gallons per year.
