Minority and Women Owned Participation




- By City Ordinance, all solicitations over Council limit are reviewed by the Small and Minority Business Resources Department for potential subcontracting opportunities.
- SMBR establishes MBE/WBE goals, all offerors must complete a compliance plan
- SMBR may approve “Zero Goals” if:
 - No subcontracting opportunities were identified
 - Subcontracting opportunities were not identified in two or more areas
 - There were not enough certified M/WBEs in the opportunities found

M/WBE Participation




- Competitive Purchases
 - M/WBEs are encouraged to respond to solicitations as prime contractors
 - Pre-bid conferences
 - Solicitation packages may include scopes structured to allow M/WBEs to propose as primes
 - Identification of subcontracting opportunities after contract award with approved “No Goals” and Compliance plans. Contractors are required to conduct good faith efforts for any potential subcontracting opportunities that occur through duration of a project.

M/WBE Participation




- For non-competitive awards over Council limit vendors complete a M/WBE Utilization plan to list subcontractors to be used
 - Sole/Single Source
 - Professional Services (non-construction)
 - Cooperative Purchases

Efforts to increase M/WBE Participation




- Process to identify subcontracting opportunities prior to issuance of solicitations for projects estimated above \$50,000.
 - Project Manager, Business Development and Purchasing collaboratively work together in review process
- Proactive Monitoring of AE contracts with M/WBE plans
 - AE Business Development Unit
 - AE and Purchasing compliance teams
- AE Business Development notifies available M/WBE firms through bid briefs, phone calls and post cards
- Training for AE Purchasing staff

- Recommend future MBE/WBE reports based on payments


