

# Competitive Matter Resolution Review Staff Recommendations

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## Commitment to Openness

### Austin Energy ....

- Supports open dissemination of public information
- Objective to fulfill mission to provide clean, affordable, reliable energy and excellent customer service.
- Obligated to protect the utility's financial integrity as prescribed by state and city law.





## Competitive Matters Principles

### Austin Energy...

- Operates in a highly competitive wholesale market.
- Supports release of any information released by all market participants.
- Supports reasonable timelines for termination of competitive status and subsequent release.





## Review Scope

- Competitive Matters Resolution Review Inputs
  - Public Hearing
  - Staff review of existing ordinance
  - Solicited stakeholder input and concerns
- Privacy
  - Customer privacy as defined by PURA restricts some information release.
  - Unlike non electric utilities AE must protect customer privacy as defined by PURA
- Oversight
  - Provide greater information on utility operations
  - Create communications process for new generation





#### Recommendations

- Reduce the amount of information identified as competitive
- Expand Annual Report
- Provide quarterly reports throughout the year
- Add data links to entities to which AE reports data, i.e. ERCOT, TCEQ, EPA, EIA.
- Improved access to commission activities and documents
- Communicate on future resource additionas
