




Water Quality Update

- UT interlocal for genetic testing in progress








Water Quality Update

- Genetic testing soon





Restoration Project Update


- Completed on schedule; re-opened June, 2010
- Original estimate \$137,500; actual cost \$110,000
- Successfully achieving soil conservation and stormwater mgt goals
- Collaborative effort (Watershed and PARD); also working together on management













Next Steps

- June 2010-December 2010: continue monitoring for bacteria levels and for impact to restored areas
- January 2011: present findings to the public and discuss management strategy for park
