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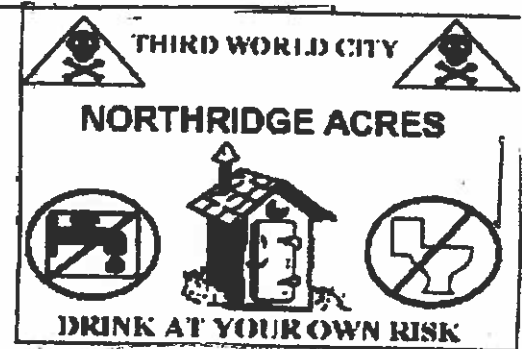

Dear Ms. Nertie:



This letter is a response to your correspondence relating to the problem of On-Site Sewage Facilities (OSSF) at the Northridge Acres Subdivision. As an employee of Williamson county for over 12 years and as the Environmental Director for over 3 years I have found that this subdivision has a severe problem relating to the proper function of OSSF. The area has the largest concentration of OSSF which are severely effected by shallow ground water table.

As you mentioned, this area becomes very saturated during periods of rain. Bar ditches, water meters, and septic system drainfields become inundated after rain showers. Furthermore, it remains saturated for an extended time period. It would be likely that partially treated effluent will commingle with this shallow water table.

In my professional opinion this subdivision should receive the highest priority in the County in obtaining organized sewer services. You may wish to contact Mr. Joe Vogel at the Texas Natural Resource Conservation Commissions' executive assistant to the executive directors office for a possible grant for the needed sewer line.
