At the July 19 meeting of the Electric Utility Commission, Austin Energy agreed utility data should be presumed public unless justification is made for making items confidential. This is a fundamental change from AE's approach to its "Competitive Matters Resolution" (CMR) in years past. At that meeting interim General Manager Robert Goode stated:

"The philosophy is that we [Austin Energy] should agree its public unless there's an exception and explain very clearly and carefully to the EUC and the community why that's an exception and the damage that could happen if its unveiled"

Austin Energy further stated it expected to make substantial progress in resolving transparency issues by the August 16 EUC meeting. In an effort to continue productive stakeholder input, our Transparency Working Group has created its own Competitive Matters Resolution (attch'd).
