A garage / studio and a porte-cochere providing a side yard setback of zero feet on the south property line and providing an impervious cover of 53 % and to erect a second story addition to the existing structure providing a rear yard setback of 5 ft. in a SF-3 district.

This permit technicality is not general to the area, and two story units at the rear property line are not uncommon in the area.

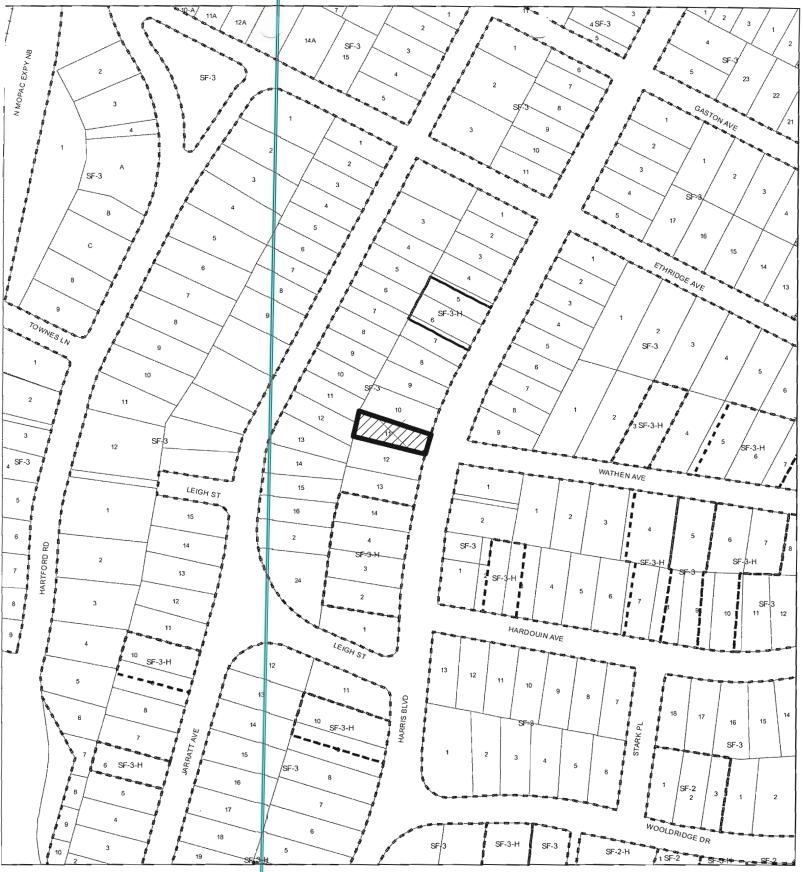

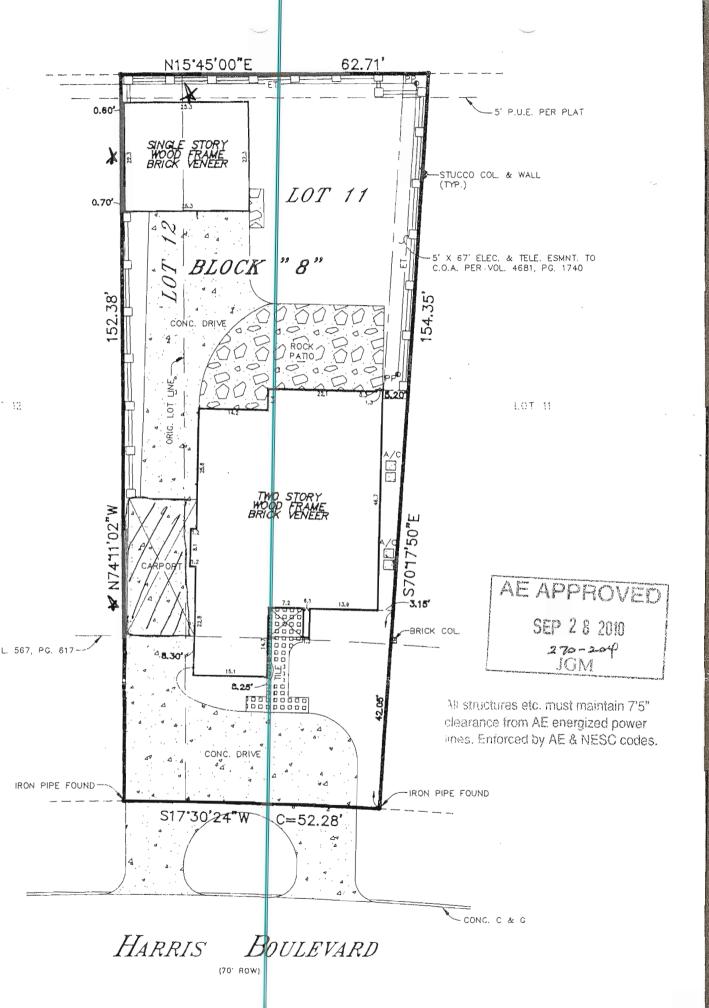
