- In April of 2010 AWU completed hiring the staff for a Second Shift. This shift begins at 3:30 pm and works until mid-night, Monday through Friday. Leaks reported from mid-night to 7:30 am Saturday and Sunday's are covered through an On Call System.

- 2. Investigated 7,380 fire hydrants for leaks
- 3. Investigated 720 miles (3,801,600 linear feet) of pipe line for leaks
- 4. Investigations performed found 121 leaks

- 2. Investigations performed found 20 leaks
