- How should the city be improved in 2039?









within aquifer recharge or contributing zones




Tons of CO2 produced annually by transportation.




Estimated order of magnitude cost of providing water
and sewer infrastructure to new development




Scenario A—"Distributed"




Scenario B—"Crescent"



Scenario C—"Centers"




Scenario D—"Linear"

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
