# What is Disc Golf?

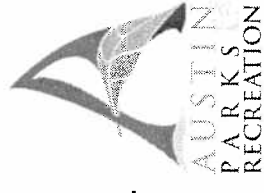
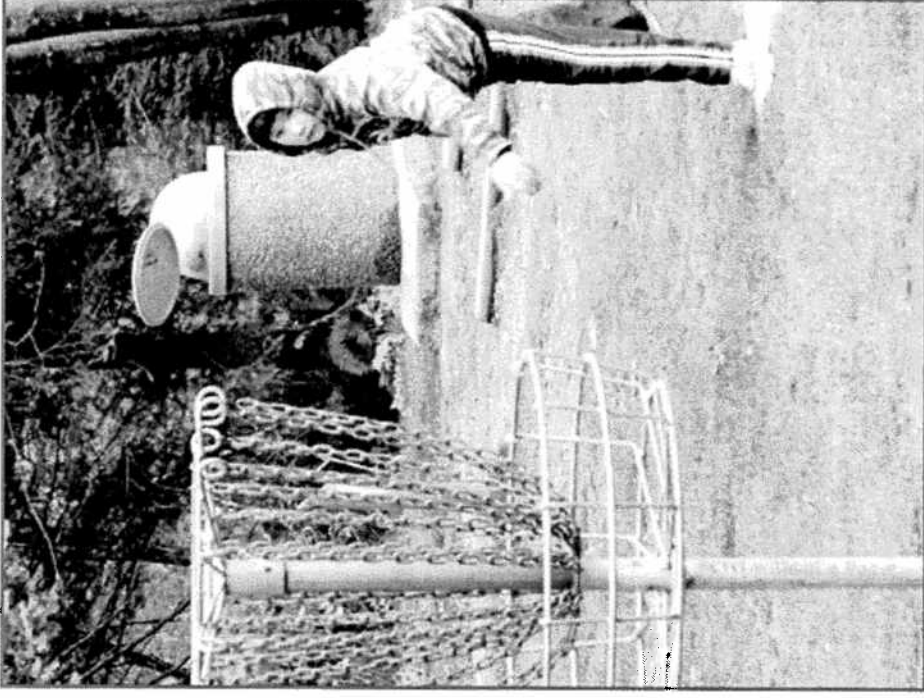
- Objective: traverse a course from beginning to end in the fewest number of throws of the disc
  - A golf disc is thrown from a tee area to a target “hole”, commonly an elevated metal basket (Pole Hole)
  - Changes in landscape and terrain provide challenges to the golfer

- Inexpensive to start & play
- Accessible for all ages
- Diverse
- Easy to learn
- Aerobic exercise
- Family activity
- Tourist attraction
- Low development cost

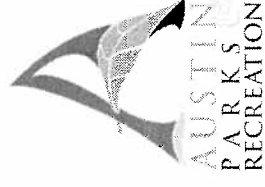

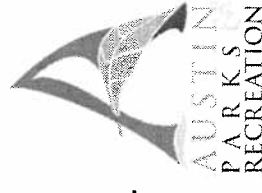


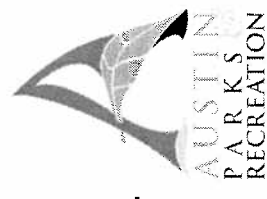

  - ❑ Minimize Environmental Damage
  - ❑ Baskets & Hard Surface Tees
  - ❑ Hole Signage
  - ❑ ADA Compliance (Some Holes)
