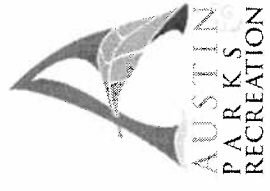

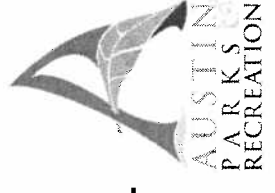
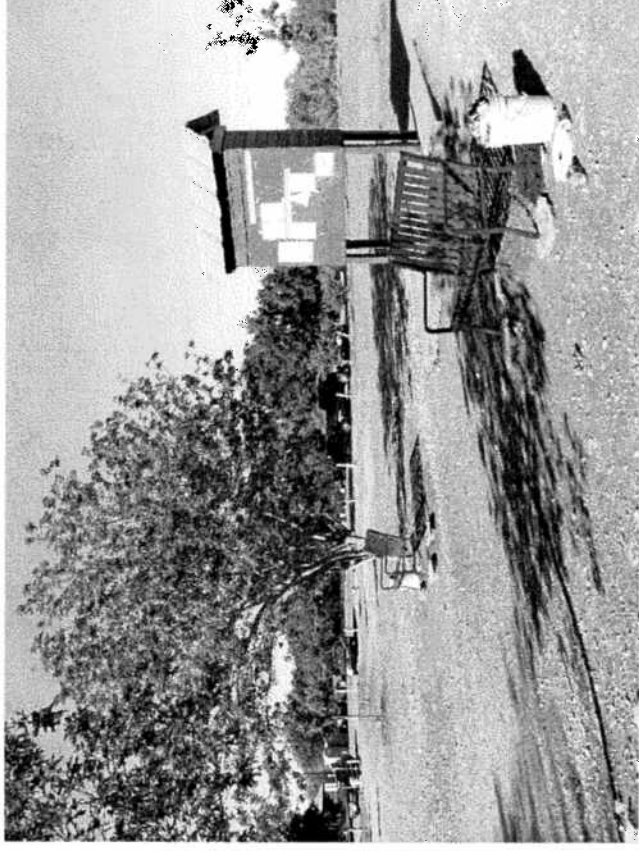


Austin Disc Golf - Past

 - Trash receptacles

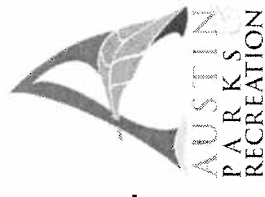

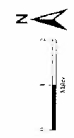




**Disc Golf Assessments

RGG Colorado River Metro Park

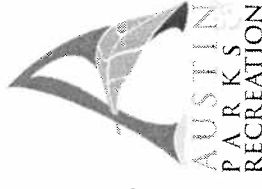
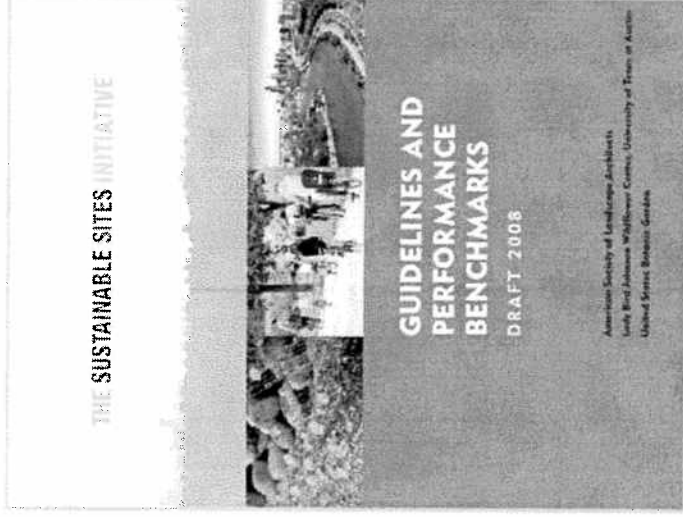

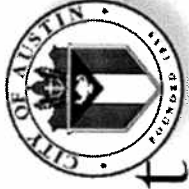




Sustainable Sites Initiative

Disc Golf as a Sustainable Sites Project

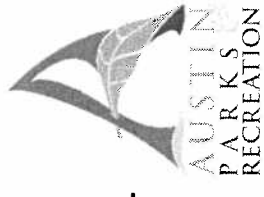
- Environmentally sound design

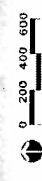




PROPOSED DISC GOLF COURSE
