Foods Prepared on Site and all open foods i.e. breakfast tacos, bulk shelled nuts to be purchased by the pound, smoothies, sausage wraps, etc.

- Permitted as an Unrestricted Mobile Vending Unit.
- The permit holder must operate from a permitted commissary for storage of food, water supply and wastewater disposal, cleaning of the unit.
- Must operate from a permitted, enclosed unit with required sinks
- Additional sampling permit is not required
- This permit is good through out the City of Austin for one year.

OR

- Permitted as a Farmers Market Single Special Event
- Must operate from a Permitted Food Establishment for any off site food preparation, servicing and storage of food and utensils
- All Booth staff must have a certified Food Manager or City of Austin Food Handler Registration
- On site setup must meet Temporary Event Requirements
- Permits are good at one market, one day per week.
 Permits may be purchased per day or 14 weeks (1 day/week)

City of Austin Sampling Permit

- Available for Certified Farmers Markets in the City of Austin only
- Required for sampling of an open food product such as cubed cheese, raw sliced fruit or vegetable, ice cream, jams or jellies spooned on a cracker or spooned from the jar; PHF beverages poured into a disposable cup.

- Samples that have been packaged at the commissary, held at required time/temperatures if a PHF and provided to a customer in the packaging are not required to have a sampling permit.
- A vendor with a Restricted Mobile Vending Permit may offer a non-PHF food product served from a squeeze bottle, which has been filled at the permitted food establishment and dispensed by the vendor directly onto a disposable utensil would not require a sampling permit.
- This permit is not intended to allow for on-site food preparation other than simple cutting, slicing or spooning of a food product.
