- 1. CALL TO ORDER: Vice-Chair Esparza called the Commission meeting to order at 6:30 p.m. Commissioners introduced themselves since there were new members.

 - **a.** Notario Publico Awareness: Discussion and possible action regarding a recommendation to City Council to address the confusion about the distinction between "notario publico" and "notary public."
 - **b.** Legal Assistance to Immigrants: Discussion and possible action regarding funding recommendations to City Council for services to provide legal assistance to immigrants.
 - **c.** Census Awareness: Discussion and possible action regarding recommendations to City Council about ways to increase awareness of and participation in the census.
 - **d.** Include invitations for participation of community based agencies in the discussion: Immigration Counseling and Outreach Services, Catholic Charities, and American Gateways.
