## 4. Approval of minutes - November 10, 2010 Commission Regular Meeting

The minutes from the regular meeting of November 10, 2010 was approved on Commissioner Rosenthal's motion; Commissioner Williams' second on a vote of 6-0-0.

## **5. Staff Briefings** (Rondella Hawkins) (wp5)

a. Legislative, Regulatory and Policy update.

Rondella Hawkins, Manager of the City of Austin's Office of Telecommunications & Regulatory Affairs report included: FCC Chairman will bring new net neutrality rules to the commission for a vote in December. Congressional Representative Upton replaces Congressional Representative Barton as chair of the House Energy and Commerce Committee.

The RFP for public access television management is scheduled to be released at the end of December 2010.

b. Update on Technology Ascertainment Survey. (wp3)

Ms Hawkins reported that the Technology Ascertainment Survey was mailed out to 1,500 citizens on November 30, 2010. A news conference announcing the survey was December 2<sup>nd</sup> at City Hall. Deadline to return completed surveys is December 20<sup>th</sup>. The final report on the outcome of the survey will be March 2011.

c. Update on 2011 Grant for Technology Opportunities Program (GTOPs). (wp2)

The 2011 grant applications were due December 2, 2010 and there were 35 applications turned in. The GTOPs Review Committee orientation meeting is scheduled for December 9<sup>th</sup>.

#### 6. Old Business

a. Discussion and possible action on the Commissions' involvement in the City of Austin Comprehensive Plan, Imagine Austin working groups. (wp4)

Motion to create an Imagine Austin Engagement Task Force with Commissioners Williams, Ramsey, Rosenthal and Touvell serving on the task force was approved on Commissioner Ramsey's motion; Commissioner Kolb's second on a vote of 6-0-0.

Commissioner Touvell will serve as chair of this task force.

The working groups for Imagine Austin are schedule to meet March through July 2011.

a. Update reports on networking relationships with other boards/commissions and groups, citywide and Austin Community Technology and Telecommunications Commission (ACT&TC) information items.

Commissioner Williams attended a City of Austin Healthy Choices Fair which provided good info on health eating.

Commissioner Touvell announced an Open House will be held at on December 13<sup>th</sup> at City Hall and 14<sup>th</sup> at One Texas Center regarding Imagine Austin.
