GTOPs is currently in the middle of the 2010 grant cycle, two of nine GTOPs recipients have successfully completed the grant:

<u>American YouthWorks</u> – Provides computer repair training, refurbished computer distribution, and Monthly Communication Workshops.

<u>Girlstart</u> – GTOPs aided in scholarships for Girlstart Summer camp is designed to increase interest in STEM (Science, Technology, engineering, and math) subjects and careers.
