Richard Hatfield called the meeting to order at 5:05 p.m.

2. APPROVAL OF MINUTES FOR APRIL 13, 2010.

Motion to approve minutes made by Scott Madole and second by Carolyn Lowe. Motion passed 3-1. Steven Hart abstained.

3. STAFF BRIEFING, REPORTS AND PRESENTATIONS

Item 3 a) Shane Harbinson discussed the Planning & Engineering Manager's Report for April 2010. ABIA Parking Garage and Rental Car Facility - The feasibility study is expected to be completed by June/July 2010. Drainage Master Plan - First workshop was completed on April 27, 2010, and Staff is planning for a second workshop. ABIA Terminal Improvements 2006 Phase 4 - Project is planned to be issued for Bid in May-2010. ABIA Terminal Trash Chute Improvements-East end of terminal has been completed, work will soon start on West end of the terminal. Auction Properties: ABIA received 20 total bids for properties in the auction held on April 13, 2010. Out of the five properties up for auction only one property sold above the amount reflected in our appraisal report. Jet/Patton lane – Twenty eight offers have been made. Twenty three of the 28 offers made have been accepted. Twenty two have closed.

Item 3 b) Shane Harbinson discussed the Finance and Operations Reports March 2010. Passenger Activity YTD up 6.44%, Aircraft Operations - total operations down .10% Cargo Activities YTD – mail totals up 7.11% cargo totals down 2.55%, belly freight totals down 14.41%, cargo totals (mail, cargo, belly freight) down 3.37%. Non-Airline revenue Detail (March 2010 compared to March 2009). Total Parking Revenues down 0.64%, total other concessions up 24.84%, total other rental and fees up 1.24%, and total non-airline revenue up 7.14%. Handouts of the entire presentation were given to the AAAC.

Item 3 c) Shane Harbinson discussed the GTSA Transactions for April 2010. See below for a year-to-year comparison.
