  - Total Awarded to City Certified Hispanic-Owned Firms \$144,463 (60.84%)
  - Total Awarded to City Certified African American Owned Firms \$27,636 (11.64%)
  - Total Awarded to City Certified Women-Owned Firms \$65,362 (27.53%)
- **Mass Excavation**

  - Total Awards to Asian/Native American-Owned firms - 0.21%
  - Total Awards to Women-owned firms - 7.05%
- Total Awards to State of Texas Certified Historically Underutilized Businesses (HUB) firms (Not City of Austin Certified): 5.13%
