



2010 Key Activities

- Completed Water Quality Monitoring and Assessment Evaluation Report
- Agreed on accounting approach for water level maintenance of Lady Bird Lake
- Collaboration on water conservation
- Technical discussions on water issues
- Committee meetings including Stakeholder Committee

Planned 2011 Activities

- Develop and submit to LCRA, City of Austin long-term demand projections including Stakeholder Committee review
- Continue participation in LCRA's Water Management Plan update process
- Continue coordination regarding LCRA and Austin pending water rights permits at TCEQ
- Continue coordination on conservation, permitting, technical issues, etc.
