


Project Goal



Select an operating partner for the boathouse to provide rowing services and concessions, facility management and maintenance, and enhanced cultural opportunities












Proposal Requirements



- An operator with at least 5 years of demonstrable experience
- Provide a broad range of services including;
 Canoe and kayak rentals, rowing programs and concessions
- Responsibility for comprehensive maintenance and facility operations
- Provide reasonable revenue return to the City
- Enhance the City's rowing tournament opportunities and international rowing profile
- Develop a contract for an initial term of five (5) years
 - City may extend for an additional two (2) year period

Jan. 27, 2011	PARD Board scheduled for review and approval, item pulled from agenda by City Attorneys Office due to potential Anti-Lobbying violations
Feb. 14, 2011	City Purchasing Office sent notice to both TRC and ARC disqualifying both responses under provisions of the City's Anti-Lobbying and Procurement Ordinance
Feb. 17, 2011	TRC submitted Notice of Intent to Protest Purchasing Office disqualification
Feb. 18, 2011	ARC submitted Notice of Intent to Protest Purchasing Office disqualification


Procurement Timeline



Mar. 2, 2011	ARC and TRC Protest Hearings held by Independent Hearing Officer
Mar. 17, 2011	Independent Hearing Office sustains ARC's protest and overrules TRC's protest
Apr. 26, 2011	PARD staff briefs PARD Board to continue selection of Boathouse Operator process with ARC as the only remaining proposer
Apr May, 2011	City staff will meet with ARC to preposition the terms and conditions for potential management of the boathouse
Aug. 25, 2011	Council review and approval


