1. Land Development Code Section 25-8-392 is granted to allow a maximum impervious cover of 12,000 square feet in the critical water quality zone provided that no new development of impervious cover is located within 100 feet of the existing FEMA 100-year floodplain.

2. A variance to LDC Section 25-8-393 is granted to allow a maximum impervious

cover of 43,000 square feet in the water quality transition zone.

3. LDC Sections 25-1-213 and 25-8-41 (regarding the processing of variances from requirements of LDC 25-8) are waived. Watershed: Slaughter Creek, Suburban, Desired Development Zone.

Recommendation: Staff recommends that City Council amend Ordinance Number 04513-20 to extend the termination date to December 23, 2011, with staff conditions.
