Applicants: Ken Johnson, Clayton-Levy-Little, Architects

Humanities Texas, owners

City Staff: Steve Sadowsky, Historic Preservation Office, 974-6454

Staff Recommendation: Recommend historic zoning. The restoration of the house

is now complete.

Motion:

Recommend a zoning change from general office (GO) to general office – historic landmark (GO-H) combining district zoning, based upon the age of the house, and significance in the areas of architecture, historical associations, and community value. (Leary/Arriaga). Vote: 6-0 (Rosato absent).

been significantly altered.

NOTE: The applicants are seeking a re-hearing of their case as they were not present at the time of the Commission's original recommendation, which was to deny historic zoning.

IV. Committee Reports

A. Special Certificates of Appropriateness Review Committee

Commissioner Kleon reported that the Special Certificates of Appropriateness Review Committee process has been helpful in making the Historic Landmark Commission meetings shorter; Commissioner Arriaga and Commissioner Myers agreed that the Special Certificate of

Appropriateness Committee establishes a pattern/precedent that is good to follow.

B. Operations Committee

Commissioner Laurie Limbacher reported that the Operations Committee continues to meet regularly (sometimes 2-3 times a month) to work on the resolution by City Council for recommendations for changes to the historic preservation program.

C. Grants Committee

Commissioner Patti Hansen reported on the Austin Convention and Visitors Bureau Grant process: The budget for the upcoming year will be an approximately \$25,000 increase.

D. Preservation Plan Committee

Commissioner Kleon reported that the City has completed the surveys and public meetings for the comprehensive plan process; the next phase of the comprehensive plan process should allow the Historic Landmark Commission to have more involvement.

V. New Business

A. Items from Commissioners

Commissioner Leary reported as a representative on the Downtown Commission on the Commission's discussions on proposed extended parking meter hours downtown, the Downtown Commission draft Transportation Recommendations for the Rainey Street area, and the Downtown Austin Plan.

Commissioner Limbacher reported that an item (#69) is going to appear on the December 16, 2010 City Council agenda regarding the master plan for the Elisabet Ney Museum.
