Event Recycling Rebate



Rebate Benefits:

- Rebate of up to \$750 towards the cost of recycling and/or composting services
- Provides event organizers with a financial incentive to introduce or improve waste diversion efforts
- Provides SWS with data regarding waste management practices, challenges, and experiences
- Promotes and helps the City achieve Zero Waste

Event Recycling Rebate

- Applies to events that are:
 - Held in Austin city limits
 - Non-political, outdoor, open to the public, with an anticipated 500 attendees/spectators
 - Obtaining proper permitting from the City
 - Not less than 2 months and not more than 12 months away from application date
 - Not receiving services from SWS

Event Recycling Rebate

- Minimum Standards:
 - Vendors may **NOT** distribute:
 - Styrofoam at the event
 - Glass at parks facilities or on public rights of way
 - Recycle plastic bottles, aluminum cans, and cardboard if used and/or distributed by vendors
 - Paid staff must be used at certain events

Event Recycling Rebate

- Rebate Process:
 - Submit the Eligibility Application Form
 - Meet Keep Austin Beautiful (KAB) prior to the event
 - Obtain all proper event permits from the City
 - Contract with a private service provider for waste management
 - Complete a Rebate Request form, including
 - Itemized invoices and weight tickets
 - Post-event survey about the event, challenges, etc.
