1. C14H-1974-0016 – O. Henry Museum, 409 E. 5th Street

Proposal: Construction of a free-standing rear porch.

Applicant: Reynaldo Hernandez, Austin Parks and Recreation Department

Committee Recommendation: The Committee reviewed this proposal several months ago and

gave preliminary approval to the conceptual design of the porch. Staff Recommendation: Grant the Certificate of Appropriateness.

Staff Recommendation: Approve the proposal as proposed.

Proposal: Demolish two ca. 1908 houses.

Applicant: Daniel Vasquez, owner

City Staff: Steve Sadowsky, Historic Preservation Office, 974-6454

Staff Recommendation: Initiate a historic zoning case to determine the feasibility of rehabilitation on this or an alternate nearby site.

No speakers in support or in opposition. The public hearing was closed. (Leary/Kleon). Vote: 6-0 (Hansen absent).

Motion: Deny the application for demolition and initiate a historic zoning case.

(Leary/Myers). Vote: 6-0 (Hansen absent).

Commissioner Limbacher asked for additional research:

- 1. Determine how much of the BMX park is in the flood plain.
- 2. Conduct additional research on the context of the neighborhood.
- 3. Determine the reason for the application for demolition.
