GAIN's board and a few members have considered it at past meetings and there's a mix of feelings and thoughts that have come out so far.

I think the Purple Bean is doing a lot of good as far as putting to rest concerns about a chaotic, unsightly trailer court al la Cheer Up Charlie's former corner at 6th and Waller, which people do not want to see happen at 11th and Lydia.

But the concerns, as usual, are noise (potential increase in number of outdoor amplified music events), traffic, hours of operation.

GAIN voted unanimously to support the renewal of Kenny Dorham's music permit. We're citing KD Backyard and Purple Bean as examples of how outdoor music permits and mobile food vendors can be good neighbors (following the rules) and improve the appearance of vacant, formerly neglected, underdeveloped sites.
