What's the status of cemetery operations and the restatement process?

- The restatement process is the result of an audit finding released to City Council last June, 2010
- Staff released the first draft of the restated agreement on June 14, 2011 for public review and comment



What is the status of cemetery operations and the restatement process?

- PARD hosted a public information session on June 28, 2011
- Public input and comments received through July 28, 2011
- PARD received 14 comment submittals from 7 individuals



What is the status of cemetery operations and the restatement process?

- Staff reviewed and incorporated 14 changes to the restated agreement
- Final draft to be released to the public:
 September 2011
- Final draft to be submitted to City Council: November 2011



Highlights of the Restated Agreement

- 1. InterCare to conduct monument assessments twice per year to identify any potential safety concerns
- InterCare to re-level monuments tilted more that 30 degrees on a vertical axis
- Clarifies InterCare's responsibility for any damage to monuments caused by InterCare or subcontractors
- 4. Adds: InterCare to monitor and re-level all graves as needed throughout all five city owned cemeteries



Highlights of the Restated Agreement

(cont'd)

- Adds: InterCare to water cemeteries in accordance with a new Cemetery Irrigation Plan developed with PARD Forestry Division
- Adds: InterCare to be responsible for spoils management and removal for all five city cemeteries
- Adds: InterCare to provide tree maintenance adhering to standards as prescribed by the City's Forestry Division



Additional Contract Monitoring Practices

- 1. Dedicated use of 311
- Regularly scheduled site inspections by PARD and InterCare
- Defined contract management oversight by PARD
