# HISTORIC LANDMARK COMMISSION OCTOBER 24, 2011 DEMOLITION AND RELOCATION PERMITS HDP-2011-0175 1108 OLIVE STREET

#### **PROPOSAL**

Demolish a ca. 1941 house.

#### **ARCHITECTURE**

One-story rectangular-plan cross-gabled Tudor-Revival-influenced frame house with a prominent front gable with a catslide roof and round-arched entry; the windows have been boarded up.

#### RESEARCH

The house was built in 1941 for Van and Luenda Williams, who only lived here a short period of time. The house was rented out in the mid-1940s then purchased by William and Johnnie Kerley, who lived here through the late 1950s. William Kerley was a janitor at the post office; Johnnie Kerley operated a beauty parlor at the house. Ethel Easley operated a beauty parlor at the house in 1960 but did not live here. Maurice Myers, a mechanic at Owens Garage, and his wife Emma lived here in the early 1960s; by the mid-1960s, the house was owned and occupied by Gertrude Glover, a widow.

#### STAFF COMMENTS

The house is listed as a high priority for preservation in the Historic Resources Survey of East Austin (2000).

#### STAFF RECOMMENDATION

Release the demolition permit. The house reflects a common Tudor Revival-influenced architectural type in Austin, and does not have the requisite historical significance to warrant individual designation.
