



- 1 (a) personal services;
- 2 (b) food preparation or the sale or consumption of alcoholic
- 3 beverages;
- 4 (c) a portable toilet serving the retail use, whether located inside or
- 5 outside of the use; or
- 6 (d) storage of hazardous materials as defined by the Fire Code.
- 7 (4) A permit for a temporary retail use under this subsection may be issued
- 8 for up to 30 days and renewed twice, for a total operating period not to
- 9 exceed 90 days.
