<u>SUBJECT</u>: Authorize the execution of a construction contract with TOLERO CONSTRUCTION, LLC, Austin, TX, for renovation work at Austin Energy's Town Lake Center, in the amount not to exceed of \$403,613.

**AMOUNT AND SOURCE OF FUNDING**: Funding is available in the Fiscal Year 2012 Capital Budget of Austin Energy.

**BOARDS AND COMMISSION ACTION**: To be reviewed by the Electric Utility Commission on November 14, 2011.

MBE/WBE: This contract will be awarded in compliance with Chapter 2-9A of the City Code (Minority Owned and Women Owned Business Enterprise Procurement Program) through the achievements of Good Faith Efforts with 7.81% MBE and 1.87% WBE subcontractor participation.

Town Lake Center (TLC) has been owned and occupied since 1986 by Austin Energy (AE). It has served as the headquarters since that time housing professional and technical staff, support groups among AE shared services, and the AE customer service call center.

Proposed renovations include improvements for the fifth floor (approximately 15,885 square feet) including upgrading existing bathrooms to comply with ADA requirements, enclosing and ventilating copy centers to comply with LEED<sup>TM</sup> standards, realignment of fire sprinkler heads, demolition of some existing interior walls, construction of new drywall partitions, relocating existing doors, installation of new doors, millwork, carpet, paint and wall coverings. Updated seating is planned for common and waiting areas.

This will be a LEED<sup>TM</sup> certified interiors renovation project and will include the installation of energy efficient lighting and improvements to the HVAC system to meet LEED<sup>TM</sup> standards.
