A. Request for Approval of Funding by the Downtown Austin Transportation Management Association—Briefing and Possible Action

<u>Presentation by:</u> Glen Gadbois, Executive Director of the DTMA and Rob Spillar, P.E., Director of the Austin Transportation Department spoke about the goals of DTMA in relation to ASMP and future considerations. They requested UTC's support for an initial funding partnership between DTMA and City of Austin.

Commissioner Lockler joined the dais at 6:40 p.m and was present for the presentation and subsequent discussion. Commissioners Holbrook-White and Schaubert recused themselves for the duration of Item 3-A and their absence is reflected in the vote.

Commissioner Demling made a motion to support the City of Austin and the DTMA to enter into an Inter-Local agreement to join the initial funding partnership to secure funding in the amount of \$37,500.
