VARIANCE FINDINGS: I contend that my entitlement to the requested variance is based on the following findings (see page 5 of application for explanation of findings):

REASONABLE USE:

1. The zoning regulations applicable to the property do not allow for a reasonable use because:

It would be unreasonable to move the primary house to allow for sufficient room for the construction and use of the proposed garage with a 10 foot rear setback.

HARDSHIP:

2. (a) The hardship for which the variance is requested is unique to the property in that:

The size and shape of the lot provide limited options for placement of a functional garage. The placement of the primary house is relatively far back on the lot, and the space available for the garage construction in the back is limited. The existing single car garage (which is structurally unsound and slated to be removed) is even closer to the property lines than the requested variance, approximately 3 feet from the rear and 3 feet on one side.

a. The hardship is not general to the area in which the property is located because:

The particular size and shape of the lot and placement of the main house on the lot is unique for this neighborhood. In addition, the rear of the lot in question shares a property line with a commercial property used as a public storage facility. Thus, no residents in the neighborhood would be affected by approving this variance and the commercial property owners would not be affected because the back of the metal storage buildings face the lot in question.

AREA CHARACTER:

1. The variance will not alter the character of the area adjacent to the property, will not impair the use of adjacent conforming property, and will not impair the purpose of the regulations of the zoning district in which the property is located because:

The property immediately to the rear (west) of the lot is a commecrial property consisting of self-storage units owned by Harrel's Supply & Service Center. There is no access or visibility between these self-storage units and the lot. I have included several photos for reference.

I have contacted the owners of the property to the rear (west), Harrell's Supply & Service Center, and to the side (south), Mr. Peter Keys, and they are both in support of the variance. I have also received letters of support from several other neighbors on Thornton Road. Additionally, I presented my intent to The South Lamar Neighborhood Association, who have indicated that they do not have any opposition to the proposed variance. (See attached letters)
