# **PROPOSAL**

Demolish a ca. 1946 house.

#### **ARCHITECTURE**

One-story rectangular-plan side-gabled board-and-batten-sided frame house with 1:1 frame windows, a one-story rectangular-plan rear-gabled rear addition, and an enclosed shedroofed front porch.

# RESEARCH


City building permits indicate that the house was built in 1946 by Rasendo Castillo; however, Rasendo Castillo does not appear in city directories of the period. The house was used exclusively as a rental throughout its history, housing Mexican-American laborers and construction workers. The front porch was enclosed at an unknown date.

### STAFF COMMENTS

The house is not listed in the Comprehensive Cultural Resources Survey (1984).

#### STAFF RECOMMENDATION

Release the demolition permit. The house has neither the architectural significance, historical associations, or integrity of materials and design to qualify it as a historic landmark.


