### Subject

Authorize award and execution of a 36-month supply agreement with COMMUNITY TRUCKING, LLC, Cedar Park, TX, to provide delivered crushed rock for the Watershed Protection Department in an amount not to exceed \$239,301 with three 12-month extension options in an amount not to exceed \$79,767 per option, for a total contract amount not to exceed \$478,602.

## Amount and Source of Funding

Funding in the amount of \$70,904 is available in the Fiscal Year 2011-2012 Operating Budget of the Watershed Protection Department. Funding for the remaining thirty four months of the original contract period and the extension options is contingent upon available funding in future budgets.

There is no unanticipated fiscal impact. A fiscal note is not required.

This contract establishes an annual supply agreement for crushed rock to provide the Watershed Protection Department on an as needed basis by the Field Services Division. Typical uses include:

- embankment, storm sewer line and creek entrance stabilization
- as fill in small scouring holes in creek bottoms, or to even footings
- as temporary berms to aid excavation
- as traction for earth moving equipment in slick areas
- as ballast
- in french drains

This contract will supply the Watershed Protection Department with prompt availability of repetitive purchases for these materials. The materials are bulky, and the Field Services crews do not have sufficient storage space for materials for more than a few medium size projects at a time.
