Authorize award, negotiation, and execution of a 12-month agreement through the State of Texas General Services Administration cooperative purchasing program with FORRESTER RESEARCH, INC., Cambridge, MA to provide licenses for access to technology research and analysis in an amount not to exceed \$55,658.

Funding in the amount of \$22,918 is available in the Fiscal Year 2011-2012 Operating Budget of Austin Energy. Funding in the amount of \$6,548 is available in the Fiscal Year 2011-2012 Operating Budget of the Austin Water Utility.
