**ANALYSIS / ADDITIONAL INFORMATION:** The City of Austin Art in Public Places (AIPP) program of the Cultural Arts Division, Economic Growth & Redevelopment Services Office sought to commission a professional visual artist to design and create artwork for the 3<sup>rd</sup> St Streetscape Art in Public Places project in downtown Austin.
